<u>FY22 Data Wrap Up</u> – ODE announced in today's EMIS Newsflash that they've started the data review period for Superintendents to sign off on LRC and related data. This information will also go out in the EdConnect today for Superintendents to see. FY22 funding appeal window is also open, where districts can file an appeal if their funding is impacted by *another district's* reporting (e.g., overlapping enrollment). Get those in so ODE can wrap up FY22 funding calculations.

<u>Community School Data Pull</u> – Tomorrow is the last FY22 data pull used for Community School FY23 payments. ODE will begin using FY23 data starting with the September data pull for Community School October payments. Over 200 Community Schools have not submitted any FY23 data at all yet, so just a reminder that in about four weeks, ODE will begin funding Community Schools on current year data.

FY23 FTE – Starting next week, ODE will begin processing FY23 FTE for both Community Schools and Traditional Schools to begin seeing FTE reports and conflicts. To help resolve conflicts, it is important for all entities to begin reporting FY23 data. ODE will also begin populating ODDEX > SOES and SCR checks starting next week.

<u>FY23S Retention/Promotion Collection</u> is closing Friday, September 2, just one week from this Friday. ODE emailed ITC reminders this morning for districts who still need to submit. A significant number of districts have not submitted anything yet, so urge them to get that data submitted.

<u>Q&A</u>

Q: Have 3rd grade summer test results been applied to the SDC?

A: There were not a lot, but I believe they were loaded last week.

Q: For 3rd graders who are being retained, the guidance is that they cannot be retained only based on test results, so do we report Retention Status "A" or "1"?

A: Status "A" would be reported if they are reading below grade level and the district determines they will not be successful in the 4th grade. Status "1" would be reported if they are reading at grade level but being retained for another reason (e.g., attendance, performance in another class, parent request).

Q: For a student who did not meet TGRG promotion on a State or alternative test, but the Principal, Teacher, and Parent all agree they are moving on to 4th grade, do we report asterisk?
A: Yes, that is exactly what is in the COVID section of the EMIS Manual.
